Guidelines for Paper Submission

We welcome paper submissions by prospective authors and invite to submission of full-length research papers (which is not submitted/published/considered anywhere in previous conferences and journals). Authors should follow the below guidelines:

- Authors are required to submit full & final paper both in M.S Word and PDF Format with Plagiarism report in the same e-mail.
- Paper format: Single Column, A4 Size single line spacing; Font size: Times New Roman (12pts). Page limit: not to exceed 10 pages including all references, tables & figures.
- First Page: Title, Author(s) details and affiliation with complete contact address must be specified. Second Page: Title, Abstract, Key words followed by main text.
- Print Area: Text should not exceed 5.75" in width and 8" in height.
- List of references must follow A.P.A style, 9th Version.
- The paper will be blind reviewed and only those approved by the reviewers will be selected for conference presentation. For accepted papers, at least 1 of the author's is expected to present the paper in the conference.
- Abstract not more than 500 words should clearly state the purpose of the work, research methods used, key findings and major conclusions drawn from the work. It is also informed that the full paper should not exceed more than 8000 words / 10 pages whichever is less.
- Selected papers will be published in UGC CARE Listed Journals, SCOPUS, Peer reviewed and ISSN . Prevailing publication fees will be communicated to the authors in person from the conference team.
- The Conference Team will update Authors regarding publication opportunities.

Review Process

1. Each manuscript will be primarily examined by the editor, and then forwarded to two referees for blind review. The research paper shall be published subject to recommendation of referees.
2. The authors shall be informed about the selection/rejection of the article/paper by e-mail only. However, the journal shall publish the article/papers of the authors completing the formalities in due time mentioned in the selection letter. The rejected papers shall not be returned.
3. In case of acceptance of the article and completion of publication formalities by the author, journal reserves the right of making amendments in the final draft of the research paper to suit the journal's requirement.
4. Number of Authors rule 3 is followed.
5. E-certificate will be provided only for registered co-authors.
6. E-certificate will be provided to all the participants post event completion.
